Picketing Information Supplement

13 February 2024

The following guidelines supplement the MSVU Picketing Information document that was released on 11 February 2024:

- 1. When crossing roads (or driveways) be sure that there is no traffic before stepping off the curb. This can be difficult when we are distracted, and your picket captain will do their best to ensure everyone is safe, but we all can do our part.
- 2. All striking people must maintain a distance of 2 feet from the curb (especially at bus stops).
- 3. Ensure you hydrate and snack regularly, especially on shifts more than 2 hours. Your captain will have both water and snacks in their bag.
- 4. When passing off megaphones or other strike materials, use the sanitizer in your captain's bag.
- 5. The sidewalk is public property and you have the right to strike and protest on it.
- 6. Ensure you sign in with your captain before you start walking.
- 7. Ask your captain to call you a car, should you need to go to HQ.
- 8. Keep the picket moving, if not part of a designated standing group (eg at university entrance).
